

K-12 Voluntary Accident Insurance Program Enrollment

Accessing the K-12 Voluntary Program Online Enrollment Forms or Printable Enrollment Forms

1. Visit www.studentinsurance.com.
2. At the top of the home page, position the cursor over **Our Services** and click **K-12 Voluntary Enrollment**. The K-12 Student Accident/Athletic Insurance search engine appears.
3. Select your state, and then select your school.
You now have access to the K-12 Voluntary Program online enrollment forms or printable enrollment forms.

Enrolling via a Printable Enrollment Form

1. Access the K-12 Voluntary Program Printable Enrollment Forms.
2. Under Printable Forms, click the desired plan(s).
3. Complete the printed enrollment form and mail with your payment to the address located at the bottom of the first page of the form.

Enrolling via an Online Enrollment Form

1. Access the K-12 Voluntary Program Online Enrollment Forms.
2. Under Online Enrollment Forms, click the desired plan(s).
3. Choose the applicable coverage(s) and complete the student information, and then click **Continue**.
A verification page appears.
4. Verify all information, and then click **Continue to Paypal**.
5. Type your credit card information, and then click **Continue**.
A message appears notifying you of whether your credit card was approved or rejected.
6. If approved, click **Complete Enrollment**.
A confirmation appears. (If an email address was entered, the confirmation will also be sent to the email address.)
7. Click **Print** to print out the confirmation for your online enrollment.

Once enrolled, you can print an ID card from website under Our Services/K-12 Voluntary ID Cards.

Important Note: Coverage under the Policy does not constitute comprehensive health insurance coverage (a/k/a/ "major medical insurance").
