



## **TRANSPORTATION**

### **Bus Riders**

Just the same as with LPPS elementary schools, each student is assigned a specific bus by the district. Students will not be allowed to ride any bus other than those assigned for their am and pm transport. Students will only be permitted to get on and off the bus at their designated stop.

Students are to be at assigned stops 10 minutes prior to assigned time (subject to change by driver) and wait until 10 minutes after assigned time before considering the bus late.

***For any student who wishes to get on or off with another student both parties must present a written request to the office, with a valid phone number, signed by a parent/guardian. Permission may or may not be granted, depending on a number of variables.***

Once arriving at school students must report directly to the cafeteria if they want breakfast. When finished eating, or if they elect to not eat breakfast, they will report to their designated areas (6<sup>th</sup> graders- 200 hall, 7<sup>th</sup> graders-300 hall, and 8<sup>th</sup> graders to the gym).

***\*Your bus driver will contact you a week to two weeks before school begins for 2020-21 school year. You may also consult Transfinder on the parish website (Ipsb.org) toward the end of July for general pick up/drop off times and stop. Your bus driver will give you more exact times.***

### **Car Pool**

Students not riding the bus must be dropped off in the car pool lane in front of our **CAFETERIA**. Please enter the South entrance to campus. Students may not be dropped off any earlier than 6:50 am.

When picking up your child from school in the afternoon please line up in the same car pool lane no earlier than 2:10, entering campus from the 1<sup>st</sup> entrance. Pick-up line gets backed up so be in line early.

**There will be no bike-riders or walkers at our current location.**
